Young Composer Composition Competition

Performance of Selected Works April 17, 2010

The Milwaukee Choral Artists, one of five professional women's vocal ensembles in the United States, invites entries for its first *Young Composer Composition Competition*. <http://www.milwaukeechoralartists.org>

Guidelines and Eligibility: Applicants must be residents of the United States, born on or after January 1, 1979.

To be eligible for consideration, submitted compositions must be wholly original works scored for 2-4 treble voices (soprano/alto). Any text may be used: texts with "fire" themes strongly considered. The work may be accompanied by piano and possibly one other obbligato instrument or may be unaccompanied. Works requiring amplification or CD accompaniment are ineligible.

Although works shorter than 4 minutes are preferred, works of any length will be considered.

Each applicant may submit up to two works for consideration. Please enclose an entry form for each.

All submissions must be postmarked by January 15, 2010; announcements will be made after February 15, 2010.

Entrance fee: \$35 per work submitted.

Materials Required:

- Copy of full score (no parts at this time): measures numbered, title of piece indicated at top of each page. NOTE: The composer's name should not appear either in the program notes or on the score itself, as submissions are evaluated anonymously.
- Program notes not exceeding 250 words.
- A brief biography of the composer (250 word maximum).
- A recording of the work (if available) in MP3 format.

For return of materials, enclose a self-addressed, stamped envelope.
DO NOT SEND ORIGINAL, ONE-OF-A-KIND SCORES OR RECORDINGS.

The First Prize entry will be workshopped in a master class with the Milwaukee Choral Artists. MCA will read and rehearse the work, and record its final performances. If the composer is present, s/he will be part of the workshopping process, and will have ample opportunity to ask questions of the professional singers. (The composer is responsible for his/her travel to Milwaukee.)

First prize: \$250 cash award; Milwaukee performance of winning composition by MCA; recording of performance by MCA on DAT tape or CD; participation in Master Class with MCA.

Second Prize: \$150 cash award; Milwaukee performance of winning composition by MCA; recording of performance by MCA on DAT tape or CD.

Third Prize: Milwaukee performance of winning composition by MCA; recording of performance by MCA on DAT tape or CD.

NOTE: The evaluating committee reserves the right to award no prize, or up to three prizes, in any given year.
